RECOMMENDATION

DISCUSSION

The Park Board has a number of locations where the Canadian Flag is flown both for the celebration of Canada Day and throughout the year. These are located at:

- Vanier Park
- Vancouver Aquatic Centre
- Alexandra Park
- Prospect Point
- Brockton Point (3)
- Killarney

and the responsibility for flag replacement is with the Environment and Operations Division.

In front of the Administration Building we raise and lower a Canadian flag daily Monday to Friday. This practise will be modified to have the flag flying year round.

A number of other flag poles (Canadian and other flags) are in Vancouver Parks.

- Brock House
- Memorial South
- West Point Grey Lawn Bowling
- Air Force Gardens (used for special occasions)
- Burrard Marina
- Morton Park
- Brockton Cricket Pavilion (visiting teams)
- Oak Park - backstop
- Kerrisdale Community Centre
- Nat Bailey Stadium
- Ferguson Point Teahouse

The flags at these and more than eleven other locations are looked after by various groups.

Many other government, military, education and health institutions have flagpoles throughout the City.
