**CHAIR'S REPORT**

Commissioner Fetherstonhaugh reported on the accomplishments of the Board in the past years. These were the establishment of the Community Centre Renewal Program, the addition of new parks such as Andy Livingstone, David Lam, Coopers, Harbour Green and May and Lorne Brown Parks. A significant project developed in co-operation with the community was the Mosaic Creek Park in Grandview-Woodlands and the returning of Grimmatt Park to green space. Roundhouse Community Arts and Recreation Centre was added to the Vancouver Park Board system. The renovated Killarney Community Centre was opened in October and there are plans to replace Mount Pleasant Community Centre. A major renovation to Renfrew Community Centre

is also planned. The Board has changed its service delivery to a decentralized module to ensure that the needs of the public may be responded to more readily. Our new General Manager, Susan Mundick, along with senior management staff and an outside consultant reviewed and implemented New Directions for the Vancouver Park Board.

Commissioner Fetherstonhaugh thanked members of the Board and staff for their support and stated that the Park Board was confident to face new challenges in the new millennium.

Board members recognized each others' contributions and achievements during their term of office and thanked staff for their continued support.

The General Manager presented outgoing Commissioners Chesman, Fetherstonhaugh, Warren and Yong with a gift.

### **CONCLUSION**

The 1999 Board was adjourned and Mayor Philip Owen was called forward to administer the Oath of Office to the new Board.
