Pricing Guidelines

- 1. Families: each person pays the Child rate.
 - To reduce the financial impact on small families and encourage more family participation.
- 2. **Strip or multiple admission tickets:** up to 25% off applicable single rates for 10/20.
 - Incentives to increase use of facilities.
- Priority times: higher/lower rates may be charged at specific times of day or week.
 - To distribute use and available times.
- 4. **Leisure Access Cards:** are available to Vancouver residents with limited income. Entitles card holder to free swimming and skating and 50% reduction of basic programs and services.
 - To encourage participation and to assist financially where appropriate.
- Those persons with disabilities who are in need of assistance to participate are entitled to bring an attendant free of charge if required.
 - To enable persons with disabilities to participate in any recreational activity.
- Exclusive use: specific age categories or groups may be given prearranged special use of facilities upon request.
 - To distribute usage over available times and provide for special tournaments and group activities.
- 7. Reduced fee sessions: specific low cost public

sessions at rinks and pools.

• To enable all citizens to use these facilities at reduced rates during designated times.
