**Lounge Kitchen Upgrades** 

# RECOMMENDATION

A. THAT the Park Board approve proceeding with a project to renovate the kitchen in Snowy's Lounge to upgrade it to a commercial kitchen at no cost to the Park Board.

B. THAT the Park Board accept the donation of \$294,500 from the Kitsilano War Memorial Community Centre Association for the project.

### **POLICY**

The Board approves all major improvements to Park Board facilities. The Board approves increases to the capital budget.

#### BACKGROUND

The existing kitchen in Snowy's lounge dates from when the Kitsilano Arena was built in the mid 1970s. The kitchen is currently used for occasional public events and for a limited meals program for the homeless. The kitchen does not meet current standards for institutional kitchens and is not suitable for preparing meals for the public.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Kitsilano War Memorial Community Centre Association would like to implement a meals program for various groups in the community including seniors and the underprivileged. A preliminary floor plan of the kitchen and a partial plan of the arena are attached for reference. The Kitsilano War Memorial Community Centre Association have secured a capital project grant of \$100,000 from the provincial Gaming Policy and Enforcement Branch for the project, and have committed to donate an additional \$194,500 to the project for a total project budget of \$294,500. The Kitsilano War Memorial Community Centre Association would like to proceed with the project.

# **SUMMARY**

Approval of the project and accepting the donation will allow the project to proceed. The first step will be a request for proposals for architectural services.
