## **APPENDIX II**

## **Park Naming Guidelines**

Proposed park names will be evaluated by considering historical, cultural and geographic elements and using the following park naming guidelines:

1. Geographic: the park, trail, road or other feature being named generally should relate to a constant feature either nearby or within that park. This could relate to a bordering street name or a natural or man-made feature. This does not preclude the consideration of a name already in common use for the park. Such geographic criteria give ease of identification with relation to the park.

2. Commemorative: when no such constant feature is present or it is desired to commemorate an historical event or person important to the Park Board, City of Vancouver, or a person having made a substantial contribution to the Park Board, a park may be named for that person. Generally, names of individuals should only be used posthumously, except in the case of a living person who has a lifetime achievement consistent with the Park Board's mandate.
