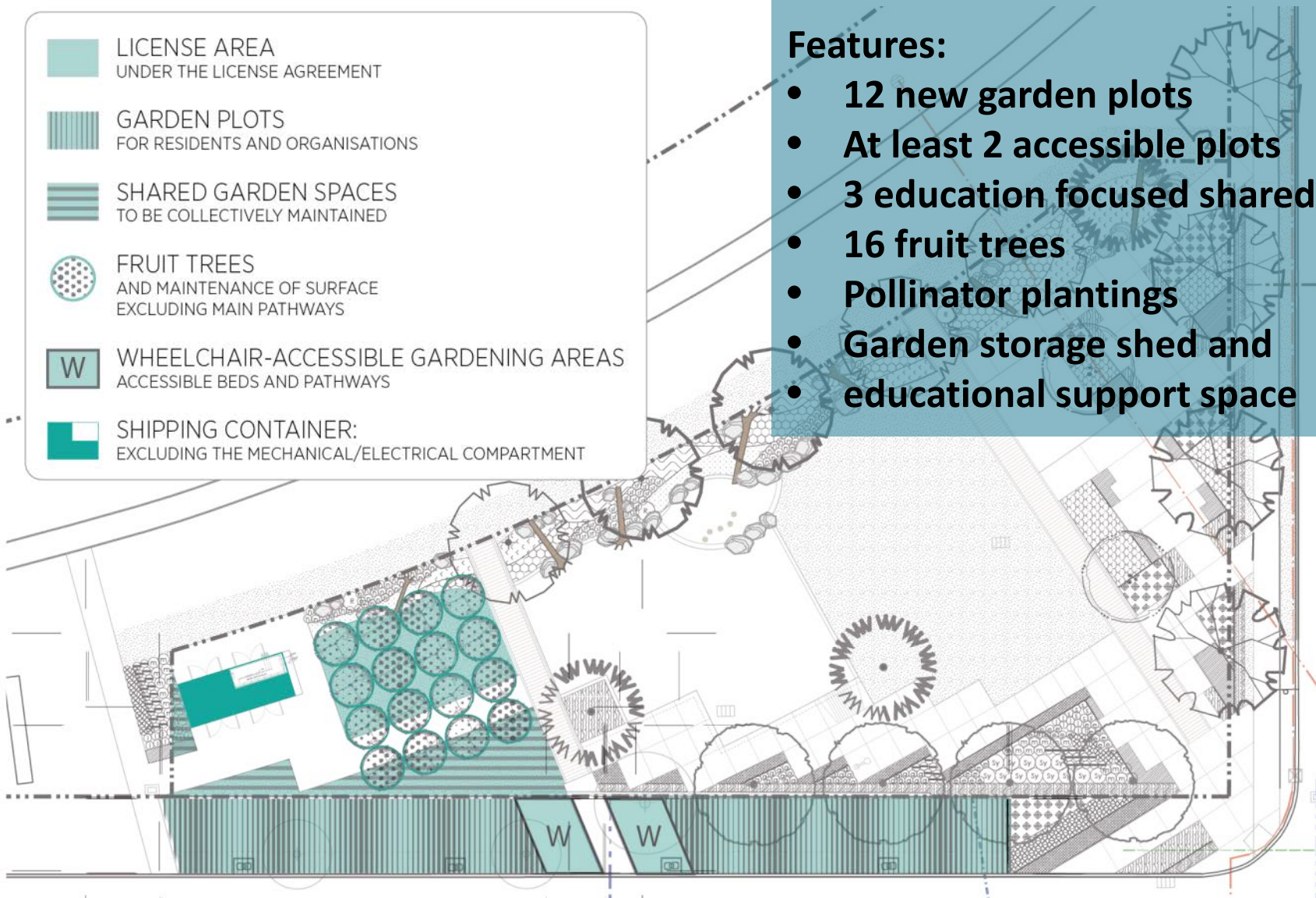

-  LICENSE AREA  
UNDER THE LICENSE AGREEMENT
-  GARDEN PLOTS  
FOR RESIDENTS AND ORGANISATIONS
-  SHARED GARDEN SPACES  
TO BE COLLECTIVELY MAINTAINED
-  FRUIT TREES  
AND MAINTENANCE OF SURFACE  
EXCLUDING MAIN PATHWAYS
-  W WHEELCHAIR-ACCESSIBLE GARDENING AREAS  
ACCESSIBLE BEDS AND PATHWAYS
-  SHIPPING CONTAINER:  
EXCLUDING THE MECHANICAL/ELECTRICAL COMPARTMENT

## Features:

- 12 new garden plots
- At least 2 accessible plots
- 3 education focused shared plots
- 16 fruit trees
- Pollinator plantings
- Garden storage shed and educational support space
