
# Highbury Interceptor Air Management Facility - Musqueam Park



# **Highbury Interceptor Profile**




#### The air management facility will:

- Address long-standing odour issues in the area;
- Reduce corrosion caused by sewer gas, prolonging the life of the sewer and reducing maintenance costs; and
- Provide a washroom, fulfilling a need identified by the Vancouver Park Board.



#### **Odour Treatment Process**






#### Proven Technology



Garden of the Province (City of Ottawa): This facility is about half the size of the Highbury Air Management Facility and is located adjacent to a high rise neighbourhood in the City of Ottawa.

- Logistics associated with the public washroom.




## Response to Location Concerns: Option 3

- Automated 24/7 monitoring/shutdown system
- Metro will conduct air quality measurements before construction and ongoing monitoring after commissioning



#### Response to Impacts on Park & Park Users

#### **Location Option 3**

- No impact on open space or off-leash dog park;
- Reduced visual impact due to screening by woodlot;
- Farther from residents than option 1 or 2;
- Closer to sports fields;
- Invasive species removal;
- Removal of 15 low value trees (according to arborist report), but re-planting at 2:1 ratio to enhance urban forest; and
- Minimal impacts to wildlife according to Wildlife Biologist.


