
- Upcycle the Gyres Society (UpGyres) is a BC registered not-for-profit organization
- Founded in 2012
- Mission is to:
 - Inform that plastics do not belong in the ocean
 - Create technology, equipment and methodology to prevent plastic from reaching the oceans, and to recover plastics from the ocean
 - Implement solutions for transforming discarded plastics into resources and revenue streams

- Inaugural event; fundraising initiative
- Money raised will be used to/for:
 - Purchase, install and operate plastic to fuel machines in remote coastal communities
 - Research and development of technologies supporting plastic pollution recovery and zero emissions, zero waste vessels
- Increase awareness of plastic waste and its damaging effects on the marine environment
- If successful, the initiative could become an annual summer event

- Ticketed concert at the Prospect Point Picnic Area Field on July 4
- Operate from 1:00pm to 8:00pm
- Feature live and DJ music performances, vendor kiosks, information booths and food services
- 800 guest capacity
- No licensed area(s)
