




THAT the Park Board approve the modified concept plan for a temporary ("pop-up") neighbourhood park located on the southeast corner of West 5th Avenue and Pine Street.

Neighbourhood Context












- 1. Create a novel park responding to neighbourhood needs for more public open space
- 2. Showcase sustainable practices (includes recycled materials, pollinator habitats, and rainwater capture/re-use)
- Ensure the design is cost effective, reduces operational costs such as weeding, and provides design features that can be incorporated into the design of the full block park

Draft Concept Plan for Public Engagement








- Draft concept plan presented to public for comment via on-line questionnaire (TalkVancouver) August 17 to September 15, 2015.
- Survey accompanied by on-site information signs and social media.
- 202 people responded to the survey: majority live in the Burrard Slopes neighbourhood (51%) or are occasional visitors to the area (37%).
- When asked "What do you think of the concept plan for the Fifth and Pine pop up park?" 38% said they "really liked it" and 48% said they "liked it". Only 14% responded with neutral or negative opinions.
- Main comments were requests for additional seating, community gardens and food production, lighting to allow for safe nighttime use, drinking water, and bike racks.
- These requests were considered in the final concept plan development.

- Revised design includes more seating areas, bike racks, and lighting on the existing building walls
- Community gardens were not included as this area is adequately served by the nearby railway corridor






















Next Steps - Schedule
