## **GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT**

Malcolm Bromley, General Manager, Park Board, reviewed the report providing an update on recent and upcoming activities within the Park Board and highlighted:

- Park Development:
  - BC Hydro proposal for downtown parks
  - Stanley Park seawall repairs
- Park Research and Planning:
  - Analysis of input from the public consultation and identification of early directions on North East False Creek (NEFC) parks and open spaces is nearing completion
  - Progress of the People, Parks and Dogs (Dogs in parks strategy)
  - Status of VanSplash (Vancouver Aquatics Strategy)

- Public engagement for development projects:
  - Consultation on the Clinton Park concept plan
  - Consultation on the renewal concept plan of Brewer's Park
- Park operations:
  - Increase of security awareness patrols in Stanley Park, focussing on the west side of the park
  - Development of overall Parks security plan with the assistance of corporate security
  - Activation of Andy Livingstone fieldhouse satellite Ranger station
- Commercial operations:
  - Burrard Marina upgrades
  - Heather Marina upgrades
  - New Harbour Green restaurant site
  - Prospect Point Café restaurant renovation
  - Stanley Park Brewing development and construction
- Recreation:
  - Warming centres opened throughout January and February
  - Hillcrest Pool hosted the Provincial Eating Disorders Awareness Campaign Purple Pool Event on February 3, 2017
- Communication projects:
  - Social media metrics
- Business development and marketing
  - Success of the Flexipass promotion which ran from January 2 to February 7, 2017
- Special events:
  - February 15, 2017 event to celebrate National Flag of Canada Day and to commemorate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Canada's Confederation
- Staffing updates.
