- Proven success in other cities
- Court murals are expensive relative to wall murals



The Artist and Process



- Scott Sueme is a mid-career artist
- member of the Mount Pleasant community
- will lead neighbourhood youth participation in creating the mural
- youth serving organizations will support involvement



Connection of Art and Sport

Paint Coat	2 or 3 Coats of MultiMate Colour Concentrate with Sand	\$4,500
Court Primer	Overnight Security For Drying	\$1,000
Artist Fees	Includes artist, assistants, and youth instructor honorariums	\$12,000
Video Production	1 video capturing perspectives of the artists, youth and the community	\$4,000
Project Management	Project, supplies, artist, curation, community engagement, youth leadership, final report, maintenance	\$12,000
