STAFF REPORTS

1. Auditor General – Report Back

The Director of Financial Planning & Analysis introduced the item and the Auditor General presented an update on the audit of <u>Park Board Revenue Management</u>.

Following the presentation, staff responded to questions related to:

- Roles of City Council and Park Board in determining finances and budget
- Park Board audit findings and performance evaluations compared to other municipalities.

THAT the Committee recommend to the Board:

- A. THAT the Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation receive the Auditor General's report titled "<u>Park Board Revenue Management</u>", dated November 20, 2023.
- B. THAT the report's six recommendations be endorsed.
- C. THAT the Board of Parks and Recreation invite the Auditor General to commence a performance audit effective January 2024.

2. The Great Outdoors Comedy Festival – Special Event

The Director of Business Services introduced the item and the Manager of Business Development presented information on <u>The Great Outdoors Comedy Festival 2024</u> event application.

Following the presentation, staff responded to questions related to:

- Transportation plans for the event, including event ingress and egress
- Policies and guidelines around commercial events in parks
- Field recovery methods for sport fields following commercial events, and the impact on user groups

Prior to the vote, the Board agreed to separate the components of the motion.

Subsequently it was,

MOVED by Commissioner Jensen SECONDED by Commissioner Virdi

THAT the Committee recommend to the Board:

A. THAT the Vancouver Park Board receive for information the report back on the 2023 Great Outdoors Comedy Festival as outlined in the report; and

B. FURTHER THAT the Board approve the addition of The Great Outdoors Comedy Festival to the annual Calendar of Major Special Events starting in 2024.

3. LOVELOUD Festival – Special Event

The Director of Business Services introduced the item and the Manager of Business Development presented information on the <u>LOVELOUD Festival</u> event application.

Subsequently it was,

MOVED by Commissioner Virdi SECONDED by Commissioner Jensen

THAT the Committee recommend to the Board:

- A. THAT the Vancouver Park Board approve an application from Brandlive Group to host the LOVELOUD Festival Vancouver at Brockton Cricket Fields in Stanley Park on Saturday, September 7, 2024, from 1:00 to 11:00pm, with all arrangements to the satisfaction of the General Manager of the Park Board.
- B. THAT the Park Board approve an application from Brandlive Group for a Special Event Permit from the BC Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch to serve alcohol at the aforementioned location and date, with a maximum capacity of 10,000 guests.

4. Killarney Track & Field Upgrades – Concept Plan

The Director of Planning and Park Development introduced the item and the Project Manager, along with the Landscape Architect, presented an update on the <u>Killarney Track & Field</u> <u>Upgrade Concept Plan</u>.

Following the presentation, staff responded to questions related to:

- Concurrent bookings for multiple track and field facilities
- Fencing requirements between track facilities and field facilities
- Field use allocations and user group conflicts
- Field lining and irrigation
- Usage overlap between various user groups
- Funding for separate throw facilities

The Committee heard from five speakers who spoke to other aspects of the recommendations.

THAT the Committee recommend to the Board:

THAT the Vancouver Park Board approve the proposed concept plan for the Killarney Park Track and Field Upgrades, as outlined in the Report dated November 15, 2023, entitled "Killarney Park Track & Field Upgrades – Concept Plan", and shown in Appendix A of the related Report, and direct staff to proceed with Infield Material – Natural Grass in the approved design
