SUBJECT: 1996 TENNIS COURT RESURFACING

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. THAT the Board award Contract T96-16 for resurfacing Rupert Park and Granville Park tennis courts to Jack Cewe Ltd. for \$119,089.
- B. THAT no legal rights shall arise hereby, and none shall arise until execution of the contemplated contract. The Board may rescind this resolution at any time up to the execution of the contemplated contract.

BACKGROUND

The four tennis courts at Rupert Park are in poor condition, exhibiting tree root heaving and cracking and thermal cracking. The four courts at Granville Park have similar problems. The amount of use the latter courts receive contributes to the repair priority rating given them.

DISCUSSION

The repair procedure will be to excavate and remove the roots, install a lift of asphalt designed to not transmit cracks in the old surface to the top of the new surface, install a top lift of asphalt for the playing surface and install a perimeter root barrier. The barrier will stop the incursion of roots to a depth of four feet at the perimeter.

The Board advertised the project and notified known qualified contractors. These bids were received:

The tenders have been reviewed and staff recommend awarding the contract to Jack Cewe Ltd.

Jack Cewe Ltd. was the low bidder for Contract T96-16 and is qualified to do the work.
