SUBJECT: LUMBERMEN'S ARCH BICYCLE AND INLINE SKATING PATH

RECOMMENDATION:

- A. **THAT the Board award Quotation 97-14 for the construction of a new bicycle and inline skating path west of Brockton Point to east of Lumbermen's Arch to Jack Cewe Ltd. for a price of \$64,710.**
- B. **THAT no legal rights shall arise hereby, and none shall arise until execution of the contemplated contract. The Board may rescind this resolution at any time up to the execution of the contemplated contract.**

BOARD POLICY

The Board will award construction contracts to the lowest qualified bidder.

BACKGROUND

The Board approved this project in principle as part of its overall approval of the Stanley Park Transportation and Recreation Report which went to the Board on October 28, 1996.

DISCUSSION

Staff invited these contractors to submit quotations:

Staff have reviewed the quotations and recommend awarding the work to Jack

Cewe Ltd., the low bidder. This work is the first phase of implementing the Stanley Park Transportation Study and its actual cost will be under the estimated cost for this portion of the work. Completion of the work is weather dependent but is expected to be completed prior to the May long weekend.

JUSTIFICATION

Jack Cewe Ltd. is the low bidder and is qualified to do the work.
