

RECOMMENDATION

- THAT the Board award contract T2001-08 to Grandview Blacktop Ltd. for the A. reconstruction of Second Beach Parking Lot and specified sections of the Seawall Pathway in Stanley Park for the tendered price of \$333,336.00
- **B**. THAT no legal rights shall arise hereby, and none shall arise until execution of the contemplated contract. The Board may rescind this resolution at any time up to the execution of the contemplated contract.

POLICY

The Board awards construction contracts over \$300,000.

BACKGROUND

As part of the 2000 - 2002 Capital Plan, the Board has approved the repair and upgrade of the Stanley Park Seawall. Consistent within the Board's policy to separate pedestrians from cyclists and roller bladers, this project advances further separation.

The Capital plan also has funds for the reconstruction of the Second Beach parking lot. The parking lot and pathway are in poor condition and are well beyond their life expectancies. It is anticipated that the work will commence on April 11, 2001 and be substantially completed by May 18, 2001 although the project is somewhat weather dependent.

This contract involves the re-paving of 2nd Beach Pool parking lot and the widening and re-paving the Seawall as indicating on Drawing 1. The Seawall will be typically widened to 18 feet (5.5 m), an increase of between one and two feet (0.3 to 0.6 m). The pedestrian and cyclist pathways will

be separated by a six inch concrete curb as per existing sections of the Seawall to the north. During construction, Seawall users will be re-routed along Park Drive, one lane of which will be closed to vehicle traffic.

The source of funds for the Parking Lot portion is the 2000 - 2002 Capital Asphalt/Drainage Budget. The source of funds for the Seawall Pathway is the 2000 - 2002 Capital Seawall Repair/Upgrading Budget.

SUMMARY

Staff have reviewed the tenders and recommend that Grandview Blacktop Ltd. be awarded the contract as the lowest qualified bidder.
