SUBJECT: By-law Repeal

RECOMMENDATION

To repeal the Freedom of Information and Privacy By-law enacted by the Park Board on October 24, 1988.

POLICY

The Board enacts and repeals all by-laws.

BACKGROUND

In 1988, the Board enacted the Freedom of Information and Privacy By-law ("1988 By-law"). Board.

In 2003, the Board enacted the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy By-law ('2003 By-law'), based on amendments to the Freedom of Information and Protection Act of British Columbia.

DISCUSSION

Enactment of the 2003 By-law rendered the 1988 By-law obsolete.

SUMMARY

Repeal of 1988 Bylaw is an administrative matter to eliminate any confusion to members of the public.
