- General Comments for Support
 - Nice to see more activities in Harbour Green Park. Due to the time of departure and return it should not have a direct impact on the neighbourhood.
- General Comments for Opposition
 - Harbour Green Park is a public park and should not to be used for commercial purposes.
 - The neighbourhood should not be considered commercial. Even a pilot program should not take place in this residential area.
 - In the official community plan, Harbour Green precinct is "primarily residential".
 - The dock is not designed for large commercial vessel use.
 - There is no additional parking in the area.
 - Cordova Street is narrow and designed for local traffic.
 - There is no adequate facility to ensure the safe movement of passenger on dock.
 - This proposal will add to congestion, noise and traffic levels in the area.
 - This could be easily handled by the Canada Place pier or the Seabus terminal.
 - The eco-tours should be applying to the Vancouver Convention Centre Expansion Project for dock use.
