Recommendation

THAT the Board approve the development of a neighbourhood oriented skateboard facility in Kensington Park, at an approximate cost of \$300,000 from the 2006 – 2008 Capital Plan allocation for sport courts / active uses – Youth Parks (BMX, skateboard).

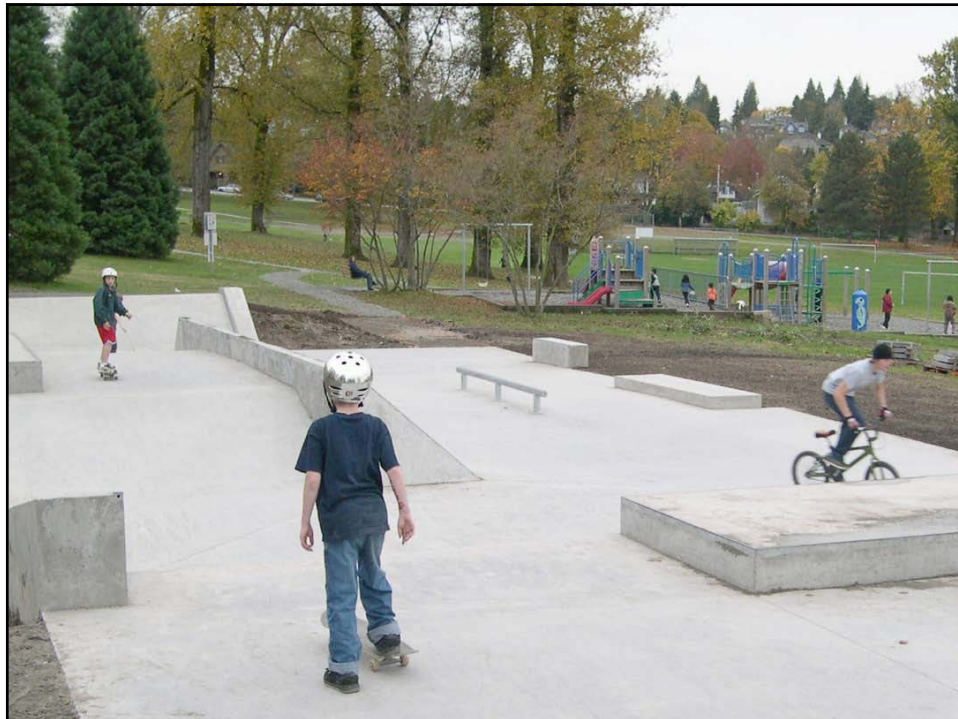

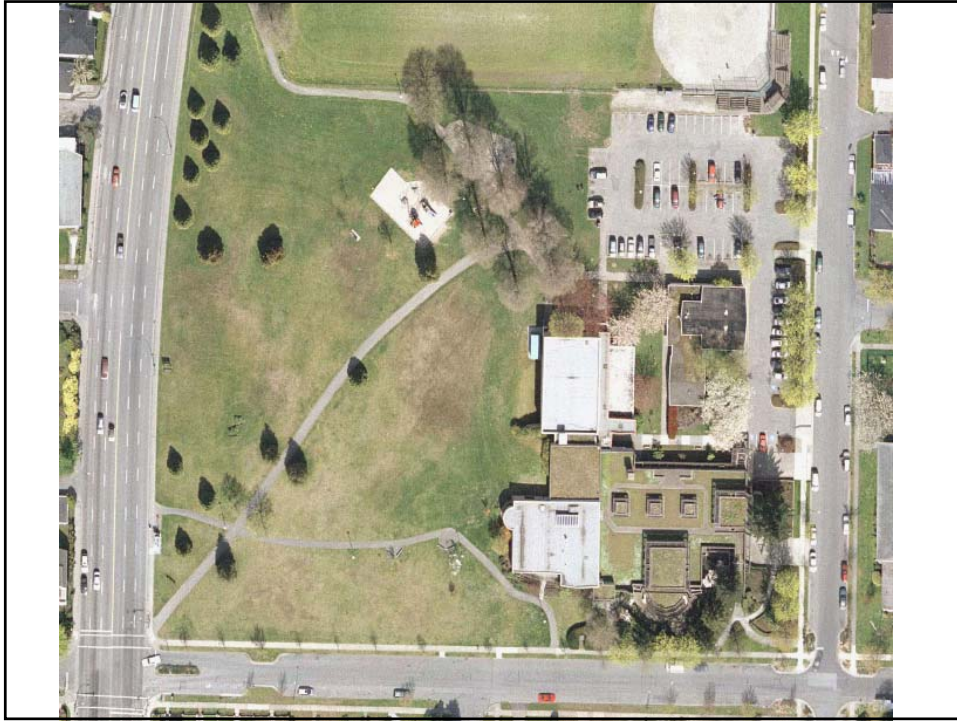


Kensington Park Skateboard Proposal Siting Criteria

Locate new skateboard facilities in parks or portions of parks where...

- A. some support services are available nearby (e.g. public washrooms, drinking fountain, youth worker, first aid);
- B. noise can be minimized for nearby residents;
- C. visible from a Park Board building or from a nearby street;
- D. other established park uses or group of park users are not displaced; and
- E. not significantly out of character with the park.
