Recommendation

- A. THAT the Board receive the City Council report entitled "Northeast False Creek: Directions for the Future", attached as Appendix A, for information.
- B. THAT the Board support the creation of the following parks and public open space in Northeast False Creek:
 - i. Creekside Park extension;
 - ii. An Outdoor Recreation Area primarily focused on hardsurface activities under the viaducts east of Carrall Street; and
 - iii. A Civic Plaza capable of hosting a wide range of special events on the False Creek waterfront on the Robson or Georgia Street axis

- C. THAT the Board is prepared to consider proposals to reshape Creekside Park extension, based on the criteria listed in Table 1 contained in this report.
- D. THAT the Board support the following elements in the Public Benefits Proposal for new development being considered for Northeast False Creek:
 - i. The Outdoor Recreation Area;
 - ii. The Civic Plaza;
 - iii. A financial contribution to upgrade existing parks and public open spaces in False Creek North; and
 - iv. A financial contribution toward the planned renewal of the Vancouver Aquatic Centre.

Key Directions for Land Use:

- Retain BC Place Stadium and GM Place Arena
- Add 1.8 million square feet of 'non-residential' uses (offices, hotels, retail stores, restaurants, institutions)
- Add about 4 million square feet of new residential uses (about 7,200 residents to the area)





Possible reshaping of Creekside Park extension: Criteria

- Creekside Park extension:
 - remains the same size
 - contiguous parcel
 - on the waterfront
 - connects to existing Creekside Park
 - a minimum depth of 70 m
 - bordered by public roads
 - accommodates a wide range of uses and events
 - accommodates the required amount of contaminated soil
 - can be built in phases
- Downtown Skateboard Plaza and Outdoor Recreation Area remain viable noise-generating recreation uses.

Public Benefits Proposal:

- Outdoor Recreation Area
- Civic Plaza
- financial contribution to upgrade existing parks in False Creek North
- financial contribution toward the planned renewal of the Vancouver Aquatic Centre
