WHEREAS

1. In 1985, nine cherry trees were planted to commemorate victims of AIDS in Stanley Park;
2. The Vancouver Park Board has maintained and protected the Cherry Trees since this time;
3. It has been 28 years since the trees were planted and 30 years since the founding of AIDS Vancouver, an organization which was part of the planting of the trees;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

THAT Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation officially recognize the Cherry Grove Memorial within Stanley Park and will work with AIDS Vancouver to develop, install and maintain a plaque or other commemorative symbol at the site telling the story of the Cherry Grove Memorial.
