# CHAIR'S REPORT

Commissioner Blyth reported on Remembrance Day ceremonies held in Vancouver parks, as well as the Open House on the Hillcrest/Riley Park Master Plan, awards event for the Get to Know Contest, and the Growing Gen7 fundraiser for Urban Aboriginal youth.

### STAFF PRESENTATIONS

### 1. Green Operations Plan - Update

Park Planner, Lindsay Cole, presented an update on the Green Operations Plan regarding zero carbon, zero waste and healthy ecosystems and outlined the policy context of Plan and the City's Greenest City 2020 Action Plan and Metro Vancouver's Zero Waste Action Plan. Ms. Cole, along with the General Manager, responded to questions.

The Committee heard from one speaker who expressed concerns about beach and mini-park maintenance.

### 2. Environmental Education and Stewardship Task Force

Park Planner, Lindsay Cole, presented the report and an update pertaining to the motion which was passed by Park Board on December 10, 2012, regarding "Leaders in Greening". Ms. Cole, along with the General Manager, responded to questions.

The Committee heard from one speaker who spoke in opposition to the report recommendation and expressed concern about the Parks Department's role in education, stewardship and advocacy, noting it should be the domain of not-for-profits and the school system.
