- Staff meetings held with SWSS to explore one year pilot option, operational considerations, implementation timeline

KITEBOARDING ZONE



- Initial one-year term
- Public awareness
- Safe environment for surfers and other waterfront visitors
- Society role in launch site management
- Evaluation at conclusion of pilot



Site - Spanish Banks West Extension



- Designated beach area with site signage
- CoV website, print communications
- Staff support (Park Ops, Lifeguards, Rangers)
- Squamish Wind Sport Society to coordinate public education campaign
 - Sport promotion
 - SWSS Liaison on site (active days)



- Signed area for access and egress ocean corridor
- Sailing boundaries 300 metres off-shore
- Promotion of safe sailing practices
- Incident response
 - SWSS Liaison
 - Park Rangers
 - Lifeguards





- Regular check-ins between staff and SWSS representatives
- Documentation of meetings, incidents, feedback from public
- Formal evaluation will inform the feasibility of permanent launch
- Board report, recommendation

- Signage installation
- Public awareness campaign
