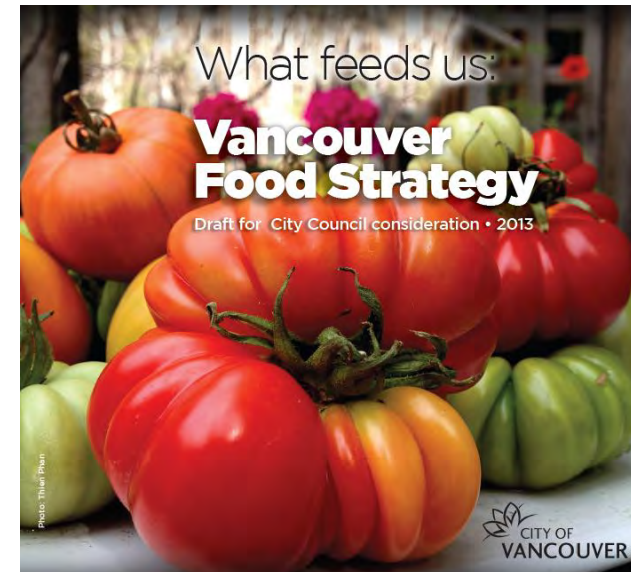
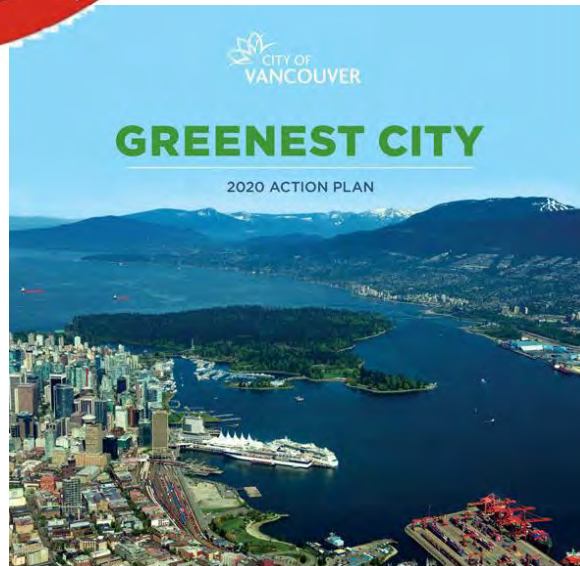

## So Far this Year:

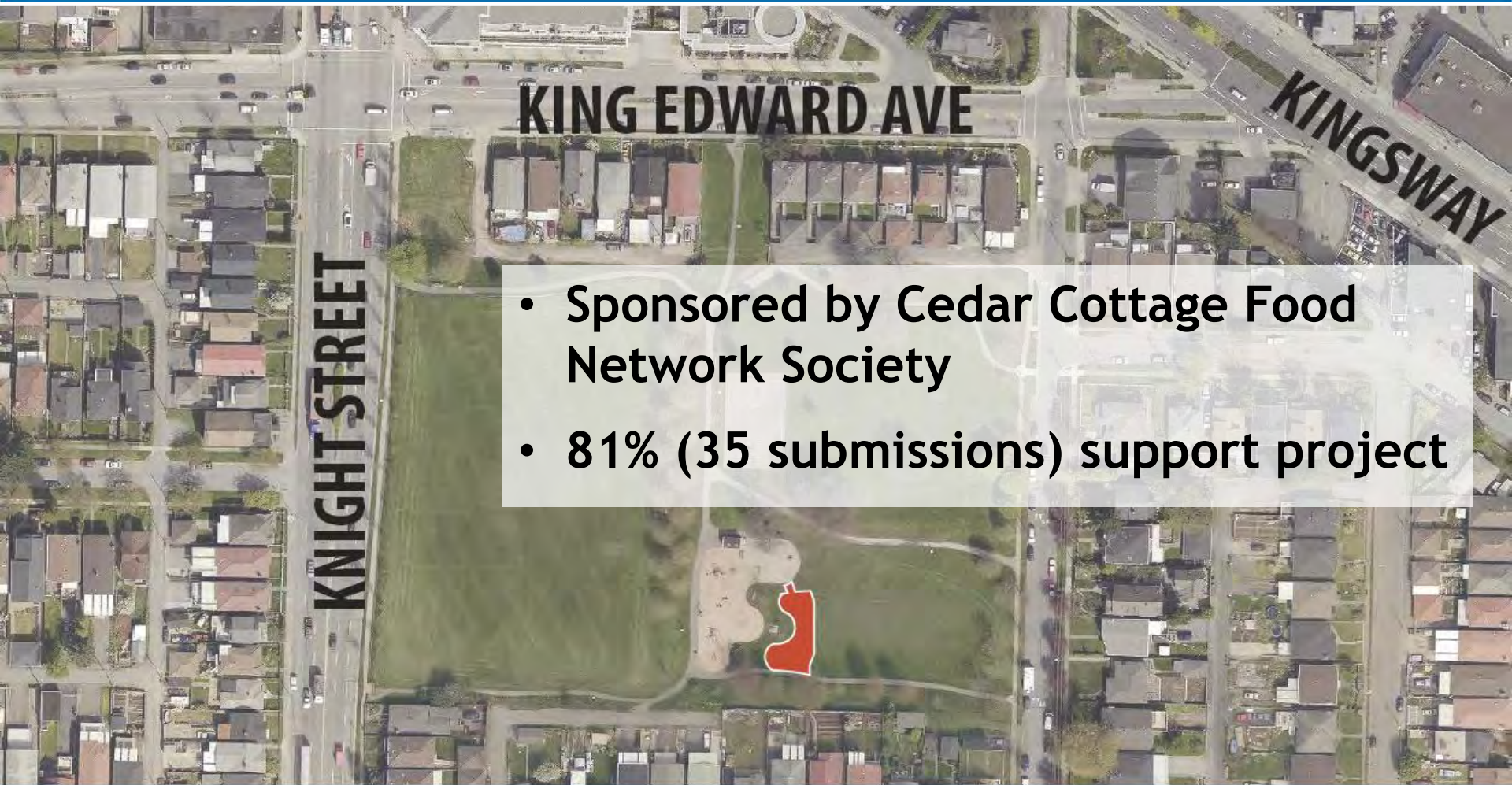
The Board has approved four new/expanded gardens:

  - Seating



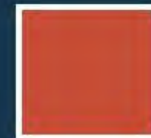


# Kingcrest Garden Site

# Kingcrest Garden Design



## Features:

- 320 m2 garden area
- ~20 allotments for all ages and abilities
- Demonstration plots for teaching and children's programming
- Pollinator gardens
- Decorative fencing with espaliered food bearing trees and shrubs
- Portion of food grown shared with neighbourhood programs
- Shed, compost production, seating
