# Background

- Event name selected through focus group initiative
- Reflects a relaxed, countrywestern themed event
- Other considerations:
  - Name was broad enough for a new event
  - Name had not been used before



## **2015** Proposal

- Ticketed event, designed to encourage community building and teamwork
- Brockton SW Diamond
- Feature a variety of "sports day" style activities, live music, food & beverage services and vender booths
- Operate from 1:00pm to 7:30pm, with alcohol service ending at 7:00pm
- Organizers are seeking approval for a 2,000 person site licensed area

### getting here

driving From Vancouver take Georgia Street or Beach Avenue and follow the signs. From the North Shore take Lion's Gate Bridge (Hwy 99) and exit at Park Drive, Park Drive is dee-way.

pay parking Pay parking is in effect throughout the park, including readways. Buy tickets at pay stations for hourly or all day parking fealed for all lets and readel.

transit Public transit services Stanley Fork from points throughout the Lower Mainland. Several routes serve the perimeter of the park and the No. 19 stops near the Rose Gorden and Malkin Bowl area. Website: translink.bc.ca

walking The park is within easy walking distance from downtown, the West End or False Creek. The seawall is a popular welking route.

#### getting around

walk, bike or blade The best way to see the park up clase and on your own achedule. The sawwalf runs around the parkmater of the park and several roads, trails and paths connect the many points of interest. Bike and reliarblade rentals can be found just outside the park on Denman near Georgia Street and on Davie Street.
