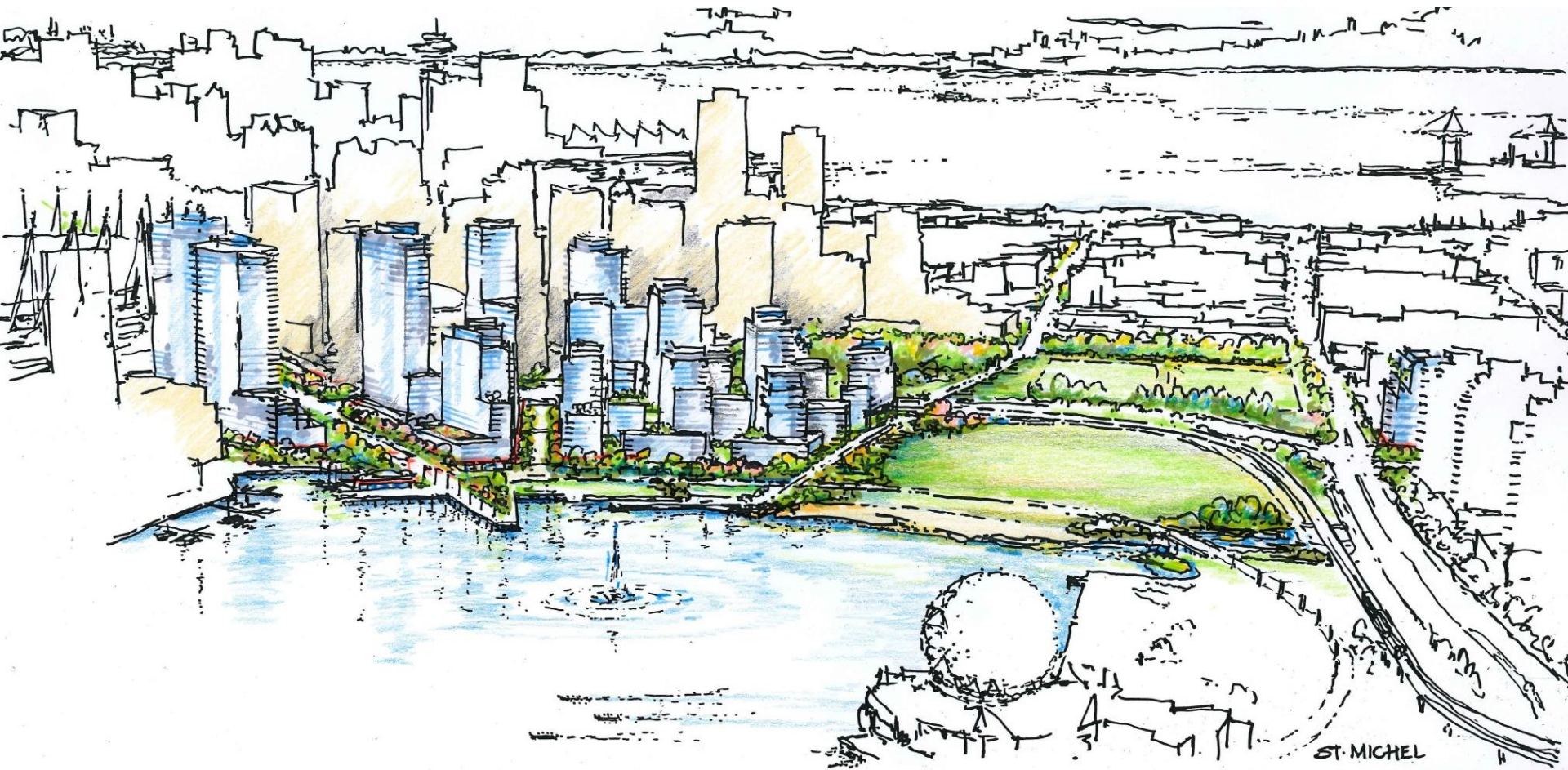

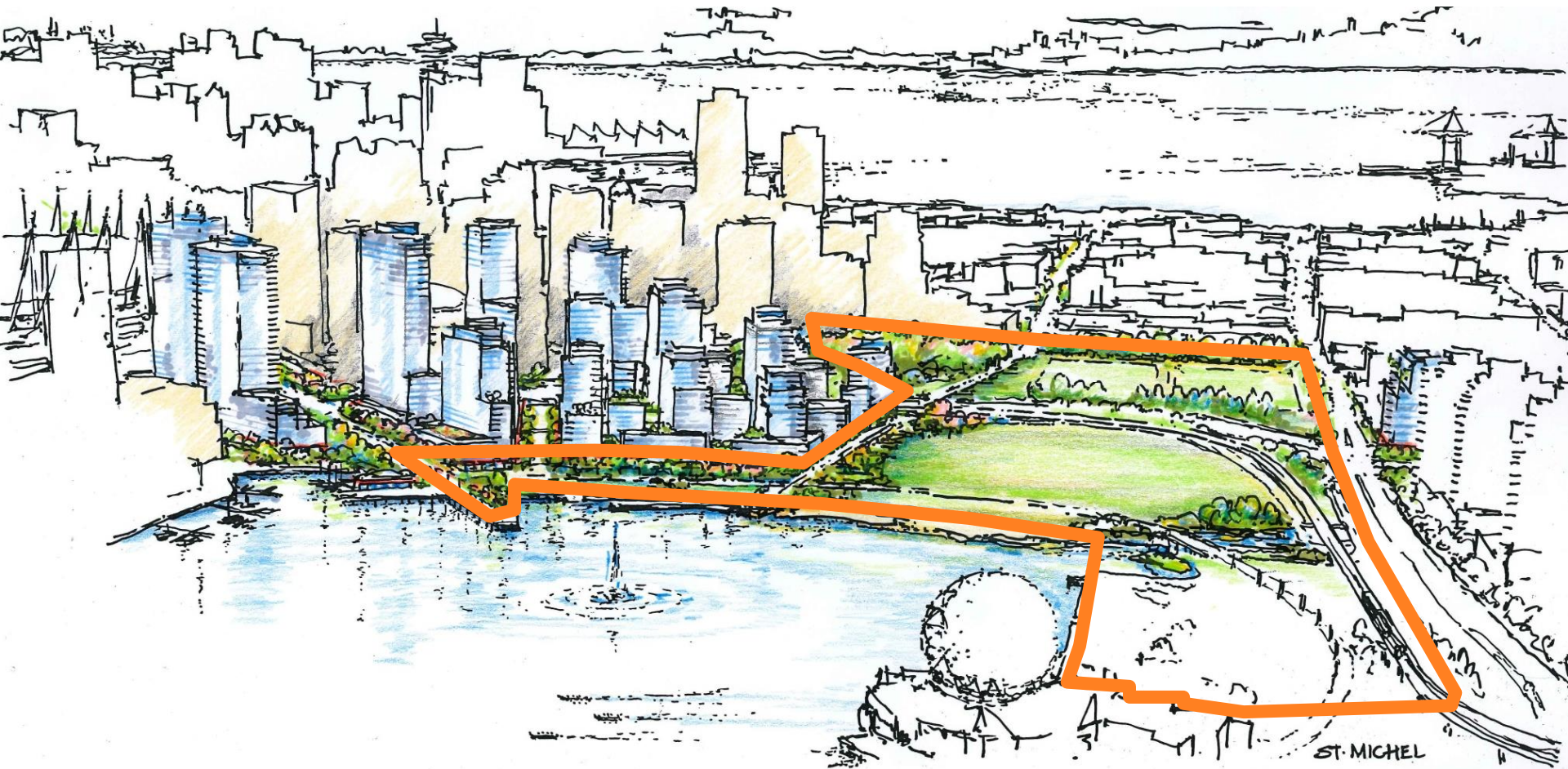

NEFC - Parks Project Scope



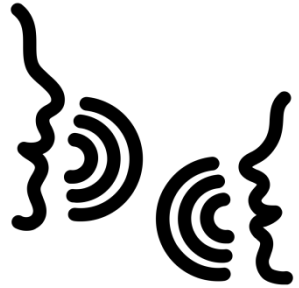

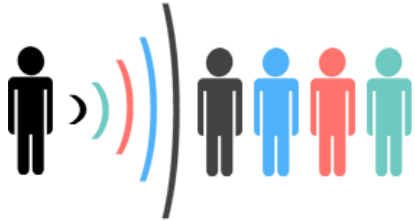
