### **AGENDA ITEMS**

## 1. PRESENTATION: VanDusen Botanical Garden Receives Petal Certification

Danica Djurkovic, Director, Facilities and Planning, led the review of a presentation regarding the award of petal certification to the VanDusen Garden Visitor Centre and highlighted:

- Design goals of the Visitor Centre
- Living Building Challenge use of a flower as a metaphor for the categories (petals):
  - Site natural systems integrated with the building systems
  - Water interconnected water systems within the site
  - Indoor quality air, light, comfort and healthy building
  - Materials no "red list" materials, 96% waste recycled
  - Energy goal is net zero energy and self-sustained
  - Beauty and inspiration

 Vision, leadership and commitment demonstrated by Park Board in the design of the VanDusen Gardens Visitor Centre.

Ms. Djurkovic introduced Susan Gushe and Jim Huffman from Perkins+Will Architects who presented the Living Building Petal award for the VanDusen Garden Visitor Centre to the Park Board Commissioners.

Ms. Djurkovic, along with Howard Normann, Director of Park Operations, Park Board, responded to questions from the Committee. It was noted that the VanDusen Garden Visitor Centre is the first facility in Vancouver to receive petal certification. There was discussion regarding the lessons learned during the design process for the VanDusen Garden Visitor Centre and how those lessons can be applied to future projects.

# 2. REPORT: Trans\* and Gender Variant Inclusion Steering Committee - Member Appointments

Paul Czene, Recreation Coordinator, Access and Volunteer Services, Park Board, led the review of a presentation regarding nominees to fill the vacancies on the Trans\* and Gender Variant Inclusion (TGVI) Steering Committee and highlighted:

- Background
- Terms of the new members expiration on June 30, 2017
- Recommended nominees to fill the two vacancies.

Mr. Czene responded to questions from the Committee. The Committee recommended that the terms of reference of the TGVI Steering Committee be revised to stagger the terms of the members to facilitate continuity and knowledge transfer.

The Committee heard from two speakers. One speaker noted the need to expand the outreach efforts in order to increase the diversity and inclusivity of the TGVI Steering Committee membership. The second speaker expressed concern regarding the lack of public information available on the TGVI Steering Committee and meeting minutes, the lack of socio-economic and cultural diversity of the membership and the recommendation that TGVI Steering Committee members be remunerated for their service. The speakers responded to questions from the Committee.
