


GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

Regular Park Board Meeting Monday, October 1, 2018



Park Development – Alder Bay Dock Replacement Project





- Engagement included a public information event held on July 17 and an online survey
- 77% of survey respondents liked the proposed dock design
- Next step: retain a consultant to prepare detailed designs and develop a funding strategy
- Work anticipated to begin in 2019

Park Development – Beaver Lake



- Consultant team finalizing construction drawings and budgets for project implementation
- Removal of beaver dam and accumulated vegetation completed
- Additional phased work to begin early 2019





Recreation – Positive Ticket Initiative



- Since its launch in February 2018, 200+ tickets have been given to youth who displayed pro-social behaviors
- 121 youth visits to PB facilities, 46% during the hours of 3:00 to 6:00pm when youth are traditionally most at risk and susceptible to negative influences



Recreation – State of the Practice: Local Threads





- State of the Practice, an annual exhibition, was held from September 17 to 29, 2018
- Featured studio for fibre, weaving, tools and dying projects sourced from the Means of Production Garden in China Creek Park and EartHand Gleaners Garden in Trillium Park North

Recreation – Wild Salmon Caravan and Sustenance Festival Launch







- Annual Wild Salmon Caravan was launched on September 22, 2018.
- The Caravan marked the beginning of the "Sustenance Festival" that celebrates arts, food and culture in Vancouver.

Recreation – Fieldhouse Studio Activation Call





- Call for new participant groups in Arts, Local Food, Environmental Stewardship and Community Sport closed on September 17, 2018
- Six fieldhouses available for activation beginning January 1, 2019
- 14 applications received; Selection Committee to meet on October 15, 2018
