Park Development – New Brighton Salt Marsh





Park Development – Douglas Park Playground






Construction proceeding well; expected completion date is in November 2018

- COV's process for a community panel to select a preferred route for the East-West arterial connection is in progress
- Panel recruitment will begin in Nov 2018



Park Operations – International Urban Forestry Congress



The conference was hosted by the Vancouver Park Board, City of Surrey and the University of British Columbia. It combined three forestry conferences into one, and was attended by over 700 delegates from six continents. It featured a tree climbing competition in Stanley Park, lectures, networking and field trips, six of which were led by our Park Board employees.

Recreation Services - Sunset Arena Closure


