SUBJECT: 2019 Calendar of Major Special Events

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Vancouver Park Board receive the 2019 Calendar of Major Special Events for information as outlined in Appendix A of this report.

POLICY

The Park Board compiles an annual list of major special events scheduled to take place over the coming year. In addition, the Park Board reviews and approves new major special events, as well as changes or revisions to existing major special events. The organization's current Special Event Guidelines were approved by the Board in December 2003.

BACKGROUND

Special Events in Parks

Civic open spaces such as parks and plazas are popular sites for entertainment and celebrations of all natures and sizes. These activities fall within the Park Board's mission of providing a wide variety of leisure opportunities for Vancouverites, and include community festivals, arts and cultural events, music concerts, sports tournaments, and various celebrations. These initiatives activate public spaces, foster community connectedness, enhance the vibrancy of our city, provide enriching arts and cultural experiences, and also provide important economic benefits by supporting tourism and enabling fundraising activities for many non-profit organizations. The Park Board's role in supporting special events is primarily that of a host – accommodating events and activities on park land. Accordingly, the Park Board issues over 500 permits per year for special events and related activities.

Special Event Permit Process

Delegating use of a park location to an event organizer is accomplished through the special event permit process. The Park Board's Special Event Guidelines set out the permit application requirements for event organizers, define the process for evaluation and selection, and inform event terms and conditions.

Large scale events which also impact locations outside of Park Board jurisdiction are coordinated in conjunction with the City's Festival Expediting Staff Team Committee (FEST Committee). FEST Committee members include the Vancouver Police Department, Vancouver Fire & Rescue Services, BC Ambulance Service, BC Liquor Control and Licensing Branch, City Special Events, Traffic Management, and Park Board Special Events staff. The FEST Committee also reports to City Council with an annual calendar of major special events.

Review and Approval Procedure

The Park Board reviews and approves new major special events, as well as significant changes or revisions to existing special events as they emerge. Major special events are defined as those activities which can have sizable impacts on public access to park space, influence on surrounding neighbourhoods, require exclusive use of an area, and/or require approval of specific conditions of use as outlined under Park Board by-laws (e.g. notification requirements, sponsorship, vending, alcohol service, ticketing, etc.). Subject to successful execution, new and modified events are added to the Park Board's annual Calendar of Major Special Events.

DISCUSSION

The 2019 Calendar of Major Special Events is attached for the Board's information (see Appendix A). The Calendar is based on events which have confirmed their intention to move forward in 2019 at the time this report was prepared. Also included in the Calendar are annual special events that have been approved in past years but do not yet have confirmed dates for 2019.

The 2019 Calendar contains approximately 100 major special events. These events are distributed throughout the year and throughout the Park Board network, with a noticeable seasonal peak during spring and summer months, and a concentration of activity in Stanley Park. The Calendar also sets out the required road closures in Stanley Park to accommodate marquee events.

SUMMARY

Large scale special events in Vancouver parks and plazas activate public spaces, foster community connectedness, enhance the vibrancy of our city, and provide enriching cultural experiences. Park Board staff have carefully considered the requirements and potential impacts of the major special events planned for 2019, and are confident that they can be executed successfully and as intended. Accordingly, staff recommend that the Board receive the 2019 Calendar of Major Special Events as outlined in this report.

Stanley Park Road Closures

The following recurrent annual events require a morning road closure in Stanley Park. Historically, traffic closures in Stanley Park have been limited to once a month between 6:00am and 10:00am during the months of March, April, May, June and September, and between 6:00am and 11:30am during the month of October. Closures are generally not permitted in July and August; there are no restrictions during other months of the year. Early morning road closures prior to 10:00am tend to have minimal impacts on Stanley Park operations. Organizers are strongly encouraged to ensure their events have concluded by 10:00am and Park Board staff work closely with event organizers to inform all Park stakeholders in advance of event dates.
