The Burn Fund began in 1978 and provides life saving, life supporting, and life enriching services to the people in BC. More than 4,000 professional fire fighters from fifty-three communities around the province dedicate their time and skills to support burn survivors

- Prevention & Education
- Survivor Support & Recovery Programs
- Enhance Burn/Trauma care & treatment for patients through investment in research, equipment & technology



# Bright Nights in Stanley Park 2018



- Largest annual fundraising event held at Stanley Park Train
- This year marked 21 years of partnership between the Burn Fund and Park Board
- Event ran from Nov 29 to Jan 5
- Over 4,000 volunteer hours and countless staff hours go into setting up and running the event
- Volunteers are comprised of active and retired fire fighters, burn survivors, nurses & medical staff and community minded corporate teams



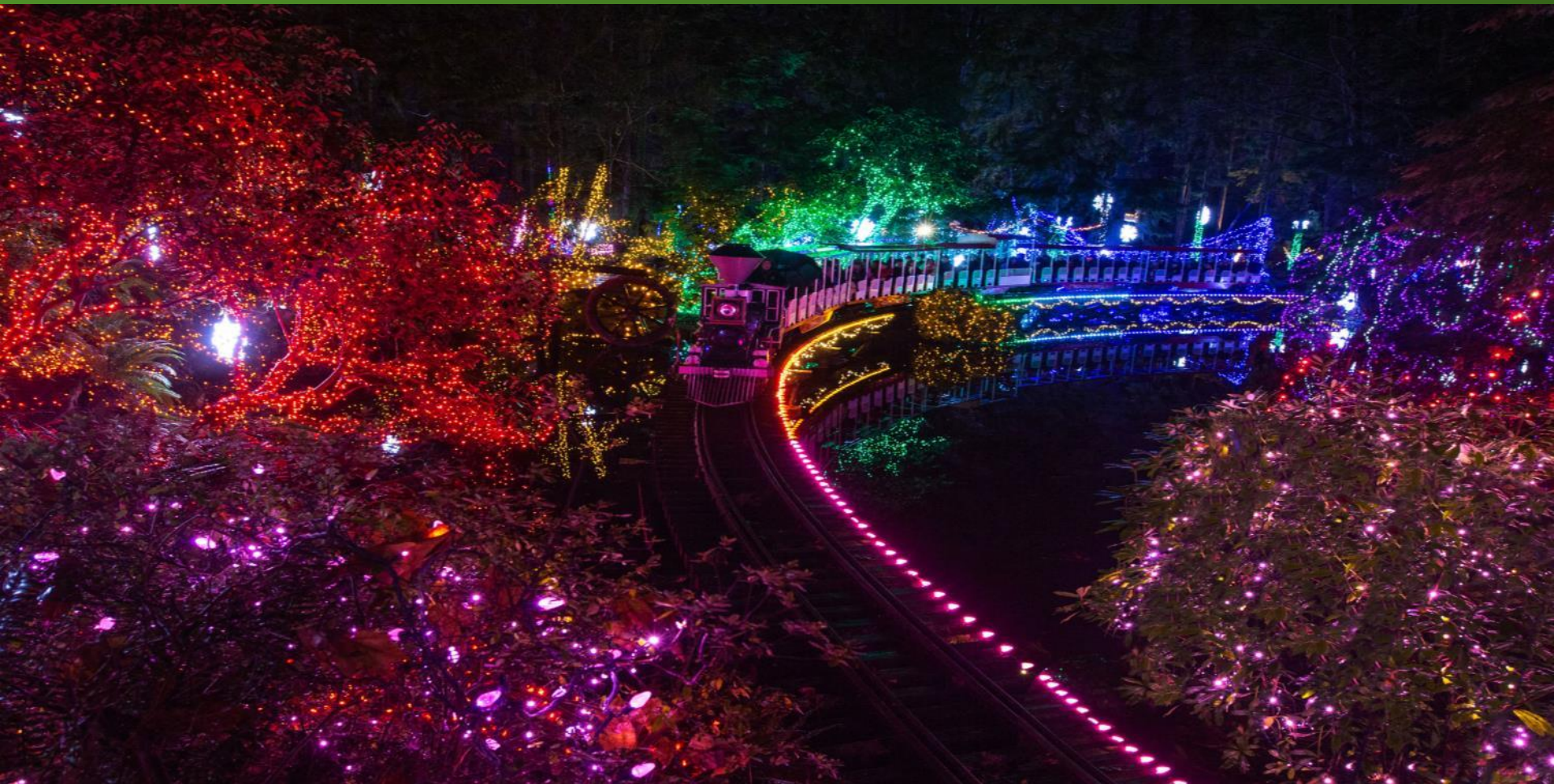
# Bright Nights 2018 Funds Raised



- Since inception in 1998, over **\$3.0** million in proceeds raised for the Burn Fund
- Burn Fund's share of 2018 net train proceeds = **\$132,685**
- Burn Fund raised a total of just over **\$357,000** including donations
- Funds raised represent **16%** of the annual Burn Fund budget for programs and services
