



# GENERAL MANAGER'S OFFICE REPORT

Regular Park Board Meeting  
June 24, 2019





- The Third Beach washroom in Stanley Park reopened on June 6th. This is part of a renewal request of 5 park washrooms requested by the board and funded through the 2015-2018 Capital Plan, which is now nearly complete.
- The Falaise, Jonathon Rogers and Clinton Washroom renovations completed last year.
- The Lumberman's Arch in Stanley Park is scheduled to reopen in mid-July.

# Slocan Park Community Garden

- The Still Creek Community Garden, formerly located at 29th Ave and Kaslo has successfully been relocated to Slocan Park.
- The area will become a new community hub building on Vancouver's commitment to local food and food security.
