

# PARK BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

— July 8, 2019 —

#### STAFF REPORTS / PRESENTATIONS

### West End Waterfront Masterplan - Project Approach

One of the most popular series of parks and public spaces in Vancouver is the English Bay and Sunset Beach Park shoreline areas. To anticipate growth and increased demand, while also preserving and enhancing the qualities that make this waterfront area so spectacular, a comprehensive masterplan to provide a consistent planning and design approach is required. The Board approved the key themes and scope of work that will inform the West End Waterfront Masterplan, which will include considerations related to park uses, accessibility, safety, operations, ecological conditions, climate change resilience, seawall conflicts, and traffic congestion. This project will be co-led by the Park Board and the City of Vancouver Engineering Department, and will include collaboration with the Musqueam, Squamish, and Tsleil-Waututh Nations.

## Playground Renewals – 2019 Contract Awards

Playground renewals are an ongoing priority of the Park Board. Staff are currently working on detailed designs and tenders for seven (7) playground renewals, with construction scheduled to start this summer or early fall. In order to avoid construction delays over the summer due to the procurement process timing, the Board authorized staff to negotiate and enter into contracts with vendors who submit qualified bids for these upcoming playground renewal projects.

### **CHAIR'S REPORT**

- July 7: Symphony at Sunset - a free open-air concert presented by the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra in partnership with the Park Board.

- Second Beach Pool Solar Thermal Project: Energy collected will pre-heat pool water to reduce natural gas use.
