



Park Board General Manager's Office Report – July 22, 2019

The following report is intended to provide an overview and update on recent and upcoming activities within the Park Board.

Stanley Park Brewing Restaurant

The improvements to the building, including renovated public washrooms on the ground floor, are now complete. The establishment will open its door to the public on July 29, 2019. As per the terms and conditions of the City's Liquor License requirements, a Good Neighbor Agreement is now in place which sets out the expectations of the City and Park Board for Stanley Park Brewing to be responsible in dealing with any issues and creating a positive relationship with the community. A community liaison group made up of residents, Stanley Park Brewing and Park Board will be established within first 90 days of the restaurant's operation.

Vancouver Pride Parade

The Park Board will once again participate in the annual Vancouver Pride Parade to be held on Sunday, August 4. Commissioners and staff will walk in the parade to support the LGBTQ2+ community. This year's theme is biodiversity and gender diversity.
