 - Emergency Action to Support Vancouver's Homeless People, Including those in Oppenheimer Park
 - Back to Basics: Prioritizing Public Realm Maintenance and Cleanliness in Vancouver
 - Expediting an Elementary School for the Olympic Village Community – the City's Role
 - A Collaborative and New Approach to Oppenheimer Park and Other Public Spaces

Council will be receiving a report on the Broadway Plan – Phase 1 Engagement and Proposed Guiding Principles which will provide a significant opportunity to advance Vancouver’s Parks and Recreation Service Master Plan (VanPlay) *Ten Goals to Shape the Next 25 Years*.

Seven of these ten goals relate to actionable aspects of the Broadway Plan:

1. Growing park space
2. Protecting existing parks
3. Equitably delivering resources
4. Creating a green network
5. Restoring wild space and biodiversity
6. Seeking truth as a foundation for reconciliation
7. Securing adequate and ongoing funding
