

Park Board General Manager's Office Report - October 22, 2019

The following report is intended to provide an overview and update on recent and upcoming activities within the Park Board.

Council Business: October 22 Regular Council Meeting

Council received a report on <u>Vancouver Community Sports Hosting Grant – Fall 2019 Intake</u> recommending approval of fourteen (14) new applications totaling \$68,500. Applications received include nine (9) local and regional sport tournaments, two (2) new sport initiative and three (3) annual sport events.

Council also received a report on <u>Social Policy Grants for Neighborhood and Non-Profit Capacity Building, Food Security and Social Innovation</u>, the report notes a recommendations is to approve a grant of up to \$81,600 to the Strathcona Community Center Association for their student community breakfast program.
