Construction work for the cenotaph access project at Memorial South Park has been completed. The following upgrades were made based on consultation with ANAVETS:

- Wider walkway surrounding monument.
- Ramped access from the North and South of the monument.

From October 11 to October 31 the Stanley Park Railway and Plaza was transformed into Alice in Nightmareland. This year The Ghost Train took over 40,000 riders on a gothic journey.
