

PARK BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS — December 2 & 9, 2019 —

The following information is intended to provide a brief overview of the Board's governance work at the Committee and Board meetings. The full agenda, meeting materials, video clips and official minutes can be found on the <u>Park Board website</u>.

STAFF REPORTS / PRESENTATIONS

2020 Fees and Charges – Parks & Recreation

The Board approved the proposed <u>2020 Fees and Charges</u>, which remain consistent with Park Board policy and reflect careful consideration of market and customer impacts, with a focus on affordability. The expected additional revenue, which has been incorporated into the 2020 Operating Budget, will contribute approximately \$0.9 million toward covering the impacts of estimated cost increases and proposed enhanced services.

2020 Service Plan and Operating & Capital Budgets – Parks & Recreation

As part of a new annual priority planning process introduced this year, the Park Board approved a Service Plan and its associated operating and capital budgets for 2020. The <u>2020 Service</u> <u>Plan</u> has been developed with maintenance of core services in mind, along with the addition of several key enhancements. The Plan is split into three external core service areas: Parks and Green Spaces, Recreational Programming and Facilities, and Business Services which is comprised of two supporting groups: Planning & Park Development and Support Services.

Downtown Park at Smithe and Richards - Construction Contract

The Board approved awarding a contract for <u>construction of the new park at Smithe and</u> <u>Richards Streets</u> to Smith Bros. and Wilson (B.C.) Ltd. The development of this much needed amenity has been part of a multi-year process to deliver new park and outdoor recreation spaces for residents of Downtown South.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Chair Mackinnon highlighted the following events in his report:

- Nov 27: Bright Nights Christmas Train, Stanley Park Commissioner Dumont welcomed riders at the launch of the train.
- Nov 29: Festival of Lights, VanDusen Garden Commissioners joined Make-A-Wish child Cameron as he lit up the 35th annual holiday celebration.
- Dec 06: Festivale Tropicale, Bloedel Conservatory Commissioners celebrated the 50th anniversary of the conservatory.

The Chair also presented highlights from the Vancouver Park Board's 2019 Year in Review.

GENERAL MANAGER'S OFFICE REPORT

The Deputy General Manager presented an overview of topics included in the <u>GMO Report</u>:

- Council Business: 2020 Capital and Operating Budgets – The proposed budgets were presented on Dec 3 for debate on Dec 10.



ELECTIONS for 2020 TERM

The Board elected Commissioner Dumont as its Board Chair for the 2020 Term. Commissioner Demers will remain Board Vice-Chair, and Commissioners Giesbrecht and Barker will also remain as Committee Chair and Vice-Chair respectively.
