- New events in 2019 (2):
 - Bacio Rosso Gourmet Cabaret Cirque
 - Westward Music Festival
- Significant changes to recurring events (4):
 - Volleyball BC Vancouver Open
 - Dîner en Blanc
 - Vancouver Mural Festival Concert
 - Bike the Night





Bacio Rosso Gourmet Cabaret Cirque

- Approved November 20, 2017
- Live entertainment experience (circus artists, cabaret singers, comedians & musicians)
- November 1, 2018 to March 15, 2019; QE Park south parking lot (approximately 15,000 attendees)
- Well executed operationally;
 subject to regular noise
 complaints from nearby residents
- Did not return in 2019/2020

Westward Music Festival

- Approved July 22, 2019
- Cross jurisdictional family-friendly music concert event
- September 13 & 14, 2019;
 Yaletown Park (hosted event's family-friendly licensed viewing area)
- Event well executed; low attendance due to poor weather
- Some noise complaints received





Volleyball BC Vancouver Open

- Approved May 27, 2019
- Free family-friendly beach volleyball tournament
- Licensed area capacity increased from 500 to 650 guests
- July 12 to 14, 2019 Kitsilano
 Beach Park (21,000 attendees)
- Event well executed; no major issues reported

Dîner en Blanc

- Approved April 4, 2019
- Surprise/pop-up dining event at iconic city location
- August 8, 2019; George Wainborn Park (3,000 participants)
- Event well executed operationally
- Key issues:
 - Event site ingress/egress
 - Noise and parking complaints





Vancouver Mural Festival Celebration Concert

- Inaugural 1-day concert approved June 4, 2018; additional concert date approved December 3, 2018
- Extra concert date not realized in 2019; open air movie offered instead on August 9, 2019
- Well executed event; 200 attendees
- No complaints received
- 2-day concert planned in 2020

Bike the Night

- Approved May 13, 2019
- Festive cross jurisdictional familyfriendly cycling event
- September 7, 2019; Sunset
 Beach Park and parking lot (hosted event's start/finish area)
- Featured 4,500 participants (35% increase over 2018)
- Well executed; no issues reported
- Featured electric generators to power sound, lighting and 2 of 4 food trucks
