STAFF REPORTS / PRESENTATIONS

Liquor Consumption in Parks By-law & Pilot Program

The Board <u>referred the report recommendations back to staff</u> to expand and improve the <u>proposed pilot program</u>. Staff were asked to specifically consider: having at least one park in each neighbourhood; requiring liquor to be consumed with food; and ensuring sites have sufficient space to support social distancing, including identifying a larger more suitable site for Vanier Park. Staff were directed to report back at the next Committee meeting scheduled for July 20, 2020.

COVID-19 Pandemic - Parks & Recreation Reopening & Recovery Update

Staff presented an update on the <u>COVID-19 Parks & Recreation reopening and recovery strategy</u>, which included an update on the services reopening in alignment with BC's Phase 3 restart plan: summer day camps, Bloedel Conservatory, concession and golf club houses, and support for third party programming.
