

PARK BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

STAFF REPORTS / PRESENTATIONS

VanPlay – Parks & Recreation Services Master Plan: Framework & Implementation Update The Board received the first annual update on the implementation of VanPlay and approved the proposed "VanPlay Framework", which replaces the previous Park Board Strategic Framework approved in 2012. VanPlay is a comprehensive suite of documents that provide the priorities, tools and policies to support the pursuit of equity, connectivity and access to parks and recreation for all. The new VanPlay Framework provides a concise method of referencing VanPlay and an effective decision-making tool for VanPlay implementation. It will allow staff and the Board to more easily articulate and advance the organization's mission, vision and key directions.

GENERAL MANAGER'S OFFICE REPORT

The Deputy General Manager presented an overview of topics included in the **GMO** report:

- Kensington Community Centre (KCCA) Update Due to an unresolved internal KCCA governance dispute, the Park Board applied to lift the injunction that previously prevented the Board from terminating the Joint Operating Agreement (JOA) with KCCA. The court injunction was lifted and KCCA is no longer jointly operating the Kensington Community Centre. Park Board staff have begun planning for the resumption of recreation programs and services starting in January 2021.
- 2020 Sustainability Scholars Program hosted by the City of Vancouver's Sustainability Group
 in partnership with the University of British Columbia's Sustainability Initiative, three graduate
 students were engaged to perform leading edge sustainability research for the Park Board.
