Second Phase – Langara Frozen Meal Program



- October 22 – launched the second phase of the City’s Non-Market Housing/Single Resident Occupancy Covid-19 Frozen Meal Program.
- Park Board staff producing two meals a day for 250 residents, total of 3,500 meals a week.
- Meals are well-balanced and nutritious.
- Project is funded until the end of 2020.

- LFAP will guide the prioritization and allocation of Park Board's food assets, services, funding and community connections for a five year term (2021-2025).
- Staff will conduct research on food assets in other urban parks systems, work with stakeholders, partners and the public throughout the month of November.
- First draft of LFAP expected to be completed Q1 2021.



New Park at Main and 7th Avenue

- A new half-block park is being developed at the intersection of Main St. and 7th Ave in Mount Pleasant.
- The new park will contribute to park access in the area and support goals and objectives identified in the Mount Pleasant Community Plan and VanPlay.
- The first phase of public engagement for the new park has just launched through the City's Shape Your City platform, and will be accepting feedback until Mid November, 2020.
