## RayCam Community Centre Playground Renewal



- Playground renewal featuring a custom treehouse surrounding a large existing sequoia tree;
- Play area serves children ages 3-12 who attend the preschool and after school programs.
- Other playground features include an in-ground trampoline, small turf area for sports, custom chalk board integrated into a wood screen, and enhanced lighting.
- Project will be completed in Q4 2020.



# Charleson Park Playground Upgrades



- Playground renewal provides a larger playground with a wider array of features to support a busy and active park on the seawall on False Creek.
- The new playground is also shared by the adjacent False Creek Elementary School
- Upgrades aim to improve and expand the existing playground, increase play opportunities.
- Through direct community feedback, accessible resilient surfacing was provided to majority of play area.
