
Inform the board of rehabilitation work by Metro Vancouver taking place this summer in the parking area on the top of the QE Plaza, across from the QE Fountains





#### **Project Background**

- Metro Vancouver assessed condition of the plaza and parking lot area in 2017
- Repairs recommended in parking lot area to maintain seal, structural slab
- Work must be done in warm, dry weather



 Staff including Business Services, Park Operations collaborating with Metro Vancouver on best approach for fastest completion



- Best approach for fastest completion is full closure for three months
- With lower tourism numbers expected due to COVID this summer, opportunity to do full parking lot closure to complete repairs
- Fewer or no tour buses and shuttle buses, fewer events
- Construction from June 1 to August 31, 2021
- Parking lot closed to buses and vehicles for this duration
- Based on no restrictions on construction activities for events and bookings during this period



- 1. Manage construction hours to maximize enjoyment for park users during peak periods
  - Regular Work from Monday to Friday from 7:30 AM to 8:00 PM
  - "Low Impact" Work on Fridays from 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM
  - No Work on Weekends or Holidays
- 2. Provide temporary alternative parking (including accessible spaces)
- 3. Limit construction access to the cul-de-sac




