A Board member asked about the status of this prospective park and any funding allocation.
- 2. A Board member enquired if the Park Board would be receiving any additional park space as part of the redevelopment project approved at TransLink's former Oakridge Transit Centre on West 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue.
- 3. A Board member asked whether the tennis courts in Queen Elizabeth Park would be resurfaced as part of the water reservoir maintenance project.
