	In the Marpole Community Plan, under "Recreation and Activity", policy 10.3.2 states: "Provide significant park space of approximately 10 acres (4 hectares) near the foot of Cambie and as close to the Fraser River as possible, ensuring the park is closely linked to the continuous Fraser River Trail." A Board member asked about the status of this prospective park and any funding allocation.	As any status update about the prospective new park referenced in the Marpole Community Plan involves sharing information about land acquisition, which cannot be publicly disclosed at this time, a confidential Board briefing will be provided. Oakridge Transit Centre Redevelopment Park Space	A Board member enquired if the Park Board would be receiving any additional park space as part of the redevelopment project approved at Translink's former Oakridge Transit Centre on W41st Avenue.	On December 9, 2020, Vancouver City Council approved the rezoning of the Oakridge Transit Centre (OTC) site on W41st Avenue. The site rezoning includes a two (2) acre permanent park to be delivered by the developer through a Park Board-led engagement and park development process, which will include seeking Park Board approval of the park concept. The completed park will be operated and maintained by Park Board staff. QE Park Tennis Courts Resurfacing	A Board member asked whether the tennis courts in Queen Elizabeth Park would be resurfaced as part of the water reservoir maintenance project.	The tennis courts at Queen Elizabeth Park were fully resurfaced in the summer of 2020 and so no further work is planned as part of the Little Mountain water reservoir maintenance project being undertaken by Metro Vancouver in 2021.
