West End Calisthenics Park in Barclay Heritage Square

- Opened January 24, 2022
- Funded through the WEChoo\$e Participatory Budgeting process (\$50,000.00 grant)
- Equipment includes:
 - incline bench
 - decline press
 - parallel bars
 - Swedish ladder
 - push up bar
 - accessible hand cycling station.



New Park at Main & 7th – Design Process


- RFP will be issued in February 2022 for consultant services
- Public engagement results from 2021 will be incorporated into the consultants design
- A temporary park space has been installed that includes:
 - Six long harvest tables
 - Raised planters
 - Beach log lounge



Kitsilano Beach Park Seaside Greenway Project – Engagement Update



- Final round of public engagement on the separated cycling path will launch in February 2022
- Separated cycle path will create a safer and more comfortable route for all users while reducing conflicts between park users
- The proposed route has been developed based on previous public engagement and other considerations
