SUBJECT: Special Events Calendar 2022 – Major Events

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Vancouver Park Board approve the 2022 Calendar of Major Special Events as outlined in this report and attached as Appendix A.

REPORT SUMMARY

Civic open spaces such as parks and plazas, as well as admission-based facilities such as VanDusen Botanical Garden and Bloedel Conservatory are popular sites for entertainment and celebrations of all natures and sizes. The Park Board's role in supporting special events is primarily that of a host, issuing over 1,300 permits annually for special events and activities across its open space network and facilities; the Park Board also organizes several events for the benefit and enjoyment of Vancouverites and visitors to the city. The purpose of this report is to present the 2022 Calendar of Major Special Events for the Board's review and approval.

BOARD AUTHORITY, POLICY, PREVIOUS DECISIONS/UPDATES

As per the <u>Vancouver Charter</u>, the Park Board has exclusive jurisdiction and control over all areas designated as permanent and temporary parks in the City of Vancouver, including any structures, programs and activities, fees, and improvements that occur within those parks.

The Park Board compiles an annual list of major special events scheduled to take place over the coming year. In addition, as informed by the <u>Guidelines for Special Events</u>, the <u>Special Events</u>, Policy (2003), as well as current practices, the Park Board reviews and approves new major special events, as well as significant changes or revisions to existing major special events.

On May 13, 2019, the Board <u>directed staff to update the aforementioned policy and guidelines</u>. Concurrent with this direction, the Board also instructed staff to maintain and support the Park Board's current portfolio of commercial events and activities, but issued a moratorium on the introduction of any new commercial initiatives until after the Special Event Policy & Guidelines have been updated and approved by the Board.

BACKGROUND

Special Events in Parks and Plazas

Civic open spaces such as parks and plazas, as well as admission-based facilities such as VanDusen Botanical Garden and Bloedel Conservatory are popular sites for entertainment and celebrations of all natures and sizes. These activities fall within the Park Board's mission of providing a wide variety of leisure and engagement opportunities for Vancouverites, and include community festivals, arts and cultural events, music concerts, sports tournaments and various celebrations.

These initiatives activate public spaces, foster community connectedness, enhance the vibrancy of our city, provide enriching arts and cultural experiences, and deliver important economic benefits by supporting tourism and enabling fundraising activities for many not-for- profit and charitable organizations. The Park Board's role in supporting special events is primarily that of a host – accommodating events and activities in park spaces and plazas. Accordingly, the Park Board issues over 1,200 permits annually for special events and activities across its open space network, and over 100 permits for events and activities at VanDusen Botanical Garden and Bloedel Conservatory. The Park Board also organizes and delivers numerous events for the benefit and enjoyment of Vancouverites and visitors to the city.

Special Events Permit Process

Designating use of a park location to an event organizer is accomplished through the special event permit process. The Park Board's Special Event Policy & Guidelines set out the permit application requirements for event organizers, define the process for evaluation and selection, and inform event terms and conditions.

Large scale events which also impact locations outside of Park Board jurisdiction are coordinated in conjunction with the City's Festival Expediting Staff Team Committee (FEST Committee). FEST Committee members include the Vancouver Police Department, Vancouver Fire Rescue Services, BC Ambulance Service, BC Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch, City Special Events, Traffic Management, and Park Board Special Events staff. The FEST Committee also reports to City Council with an annual calendar of major special events.

Review and Approval Process

The Park Board reviews and approves new major special events, as well as significant changes or revisions to existing special events as they emerge. Major special events are defined as those activities which can have sizable impacts on public access to park space, influence on surrounding neighbourhoods, require exclusive use of an area, and/or require approval of specific conditions of use as outlined under Park Board by-laws (e.g. notification requirements, sponsorship, vending, licensed/alcohol service, ticketing, etc.). Subject to successful execution, new and modified events are added to the Park Board's annual Calendar of Major Special Events.

DISCUSSION

The 2022 Calendar of Major Special Events is attached for the Board's review and approval (see Appendix A). The Calendar is based on events which have confirmed their intention to move forward in 2022 at the time this report was prepared. Also included in the Calendar are annual special events that have been approved in past years but do not yet have confirmed dates for 2022 or are still awaiting confirmation.

After the devastating impacts of the pandemic on the event sector in 2020 and 2021, which resulted in the cancelation of all but a few initiatives during this period, the 2022 Calendar anticipates a significant recovery of major events over the coming year. Accordingly, the Calendar contains 89 major special events, including:

- 6 Park Board organized and delivered events;
- 2 events delivered by external partners at VanDusen Botanical Garden; and
- 81 events delivered by external partners across Vancouver parks and plazas.

These events are distributed throughout the year and throughout the Park Board network, with a noticeable seasonal peak during the spring and summer months, and a concentration of activity in Stanley Park. The Calendar also sets out the required road closures in Stanley Park to accommodate marquee events.

CONCLUSION

Large scale special events in Vancouver parks, plazas and facilities activate public spaces, foster community connectedness, enhance the vibrancy of our city and provide enriching cultural experiences. Park Board staff have carefully considered the requirements and potential impacts of the major special events planned for 2022, and are confident that they can be executed successfully and as intended. Accordingly, staff recommend that the Board approve the 2022 Calendar of Major Special Events attached as Appendix A.

Stanley Park Road Closures

The following recurrent annual events require a morning road closure in Stanley Park. Historically, traffic closures in Stanley Park have been limited to once a month between 6:00am and 10:00am during the months of March, April, May, June and September, and between 6:00am and 11:30am during the month of October. Closures are generally not permitted in July and August; there are no restrictions during other months of the year. Early morning road closures prior to 10:00am tend to have minimal impacts on Stanley Park operations. Organizers are strongly encouraged to ensure their events have concluded by 10:00am and Park Board staff work closely with event organizers to inform all Park stakeholders in advance of event dates.
