#### Spring Strings at VanDusen Botanical Garden

#### East Fraser Lands New Park Construction (South Kinross)





- Construction for South Kinross Park is going out for tender in early June
- If approved, construction would start in late summer 2022 with a scheduled completion date in the fall of 2023.
- The last of 3 parks to be delivered along Kinross Avenue in the East Fraser Lands. South Kinross Park is a destination playground with an extensive storm water wetland.
- Estimated construction cost is \$4.0M

## **Upcoming Council Business**



- Council to receive a report regarding Development Application and Permitting Modernization Task Force – Report Back on Design Guidelines and Protection of Trees By-Law Policies on June 7.
- Council to receive a referral report regarding the East Fraser Lands Waterfront Precinct on June 7, which includes considerations for the in-kind delivery of the community centre. This would shift responsibility for design and construction from the City to the developer, and in doing so, would secure a funding mechanism and timeline for the delivery of the new centre..
- Council to receive a report on the Sites for 2022 Alcohol Consumption in Public Plazas Program on June 8, outlining the locations for this year's program and the by-law amendments necessary for this program.

## **Upcoming Council Business**



- Council to receive a report on Making Strides: Vancouver's Childcare Strategy, with recommendations from staff that would support the strategy and increased childcare in Vancouver.
- Council to reconvene on June 9 to continue asking questions of staff followed by a debate and decision on the Broadway Plan.
- At the June 14th Public Hearing, Council will be considering a rezoning of 1406-1410 East King Edward Avenue to permit the development of a 13storey mixed-use building, with 109 social housing units, led by the Vancouver Affordable Housing Agency.
