- Staff will be issuing a Request for Proposals (RFP) in August for services to support public engagement and development of a concept design for the new park in Burrard Slopes



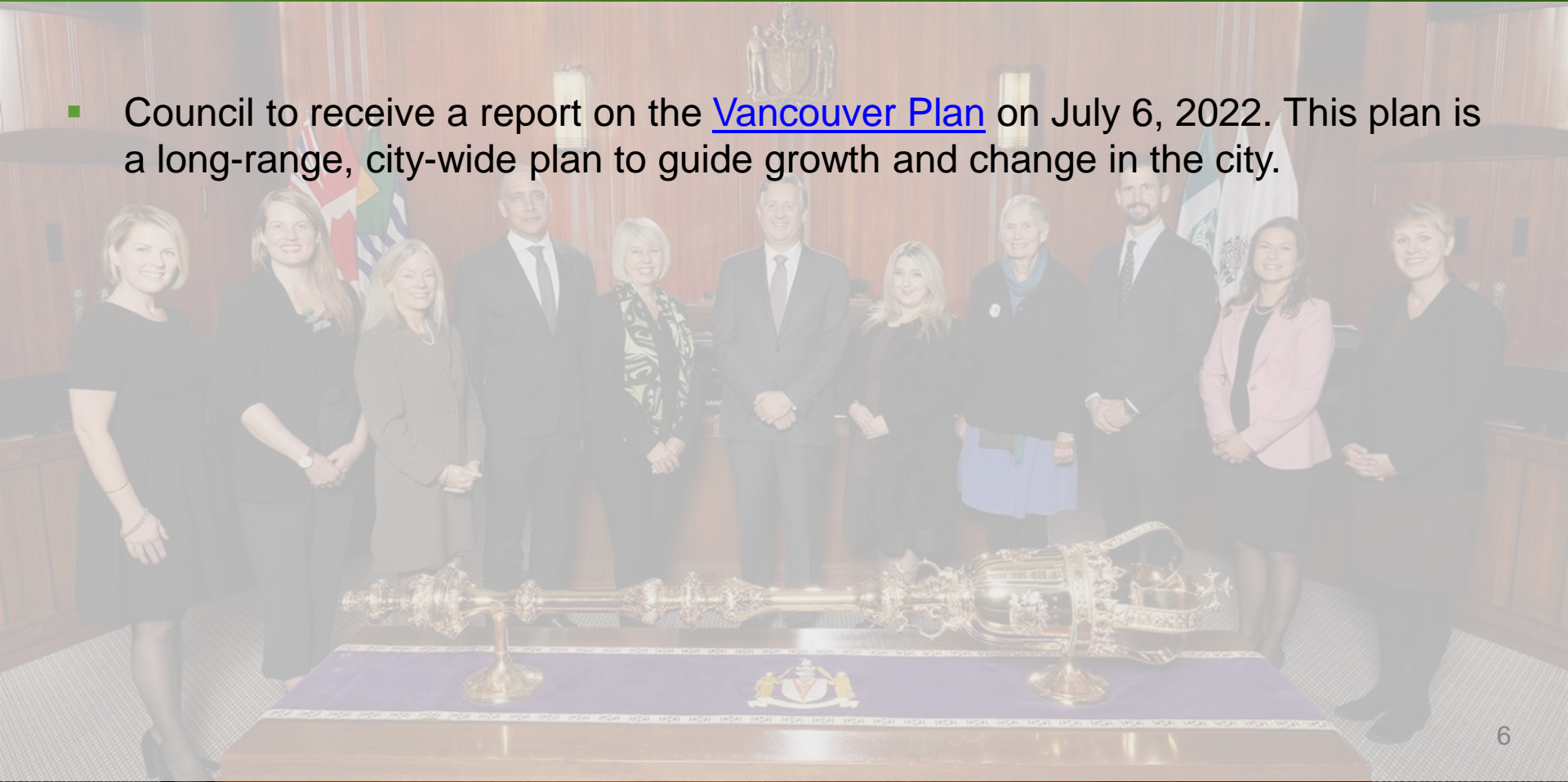
- Sunflowers have been planted at City Hall & the Park Board Admin Building

- The flowers are expected to bloom in August



- Upon inspection, staff discovered a gap in the base of the pond, requiring replacement.
- The weir has now been replaced and the pond has been filled
- Park Board staff will continue to monitor water levels
