4-Jul-22	Grays Park Dog Off Leash Area - Public Consultation	A Board member requested an update be provided on the outcomes of the July 5 & 9 engagement sessions in Grays Park that were scheduled to provide opportunities for residents to speak directly with staff regarding park renewal and requests to continue using the fenced lawn bowling area as an off leash dog park.	Park Board staff met with residents and Grays Park users on July 5th and July 9th to respond to questions related to the former lawn bowling facility deconstruction, the same area that is currently being used as an un-sanctioned dog Off-Leash Area (OLA). Staff shared information regarding the current OLA prioritization plan and the People, Parks, and Dogs Strategy, along with capital plan and park renewal processes. Questions and contact information from community members were collected - some were supportive and some were opposed to an OLA in Grays Park. Within the next week, staff will be following-up with community members with a summary from the information sessions.
